The United States Volt Hockey Association (USVHA) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to growing **volt hockey** in the U.S. and providing people with physical disabilities the opportunity to experience the joy and competition of **adaptive team sports**.

What is Volt Hockey?

Volt hockey is a 3v3 adaptive sport designed for people with limited upper and lower body mobility, such as those with muscular dystrophy. Played on a basketball court, it **combines elements of go-karting and hockey**, with players using motorized chairs equipped with paddles to maneuver a ball. These customizable chairs reach speeds of up to 10 mph, creating a fast-paced, competitive game where athletes of various ages and abilities can compete on a level playing field.

Origins and Growth in the USA

Volt hockey originated in Denmark in the 1990s and has since gained popularity across Scandinavia and Canada. In 2021, the first U.S. volt hockey team—the Boston Whiplash—was formed, bringing the sport to American athletes for the first time. Since then, the USVHA has been working to expand the sport nationwide, helping players, families, and communities build new teams and access this one of a kind adaptive sport.



Volt hockey is more than a sport. It's a life-changing opportunity for people with disabilities to compete, build friendships, and gain confidence.
